ABOUT THE SEMINAR

People want to move from a place where there are no socio amenities (rural), to where there are socio amenities (cities). Rural-Urban Migration has become too rampant especially in the Chhattisgarh State. The implications of this movement are that while most of our urban centers suffer from over population of people and activities, rural areas are often under populated. "PUSH & PULL" hypothesis provides probable explanation for it. The various aspects of impacts of labor migration from Chhattisgarh on migrants' families and their life settings with reference to COVID-19 will be discussed. The policy recommendations to address the negative consequences of the same will be resolved and will be forwarded to the State Government.
